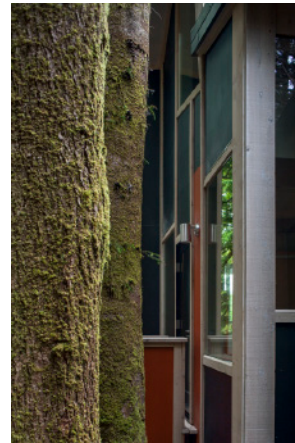


Coleman Creek Residence

SITE & PROGRAM

Located within walking distance of the Pacific Ocean, this property is in a second generation mixed forest of Western Hemlock and Sitka Spruce on the upland area of the property, and a small wetlands zone with deciduous trees and a perennial creek in the lower area. The natural qualities of the site inform the layout and spatial arrangement of the future house and guest residence; with views back through the forest, overlooking the wetlands, and distant ocean views toward the northwest.

The design is arranged as a series of buildings with wind and weather sheltered transitional spaces joined by an over sailing roof, and is intended to provide indoor- outdoor flexibility depending on the season, and to accommodate the client's needs over time.
